

Discussion:

Peter writes of our need to apply "diligence to our faith, to develop moral excellence, and in moral excellence, knowledge, and in your knowledge, self control, and in your self control, steadfastness, and in your steadfastness, godliness, and in your godliness, brotherly affection, and in your brotherly affection, love." Do any one of these many layers of faith specifically speak to you that you need to apply more diligence to?
- 3. Is there one you feel you are especially confident in?
- 4. Peter writes you will experience greater purpose and productivity when these "qualities are yours and increasing." Do you have a clear focus or vision of purpose that you can share?
- 5. Both Peter and Jude warn of false teachers, of their subtly and as Jude writes, "certain people have crept in unnoticed," and they are "hidden reefs," waiting to destruct and destroy. Have you any recognition of such a "hidden reef?"
